

Creating a bootable USB Stick

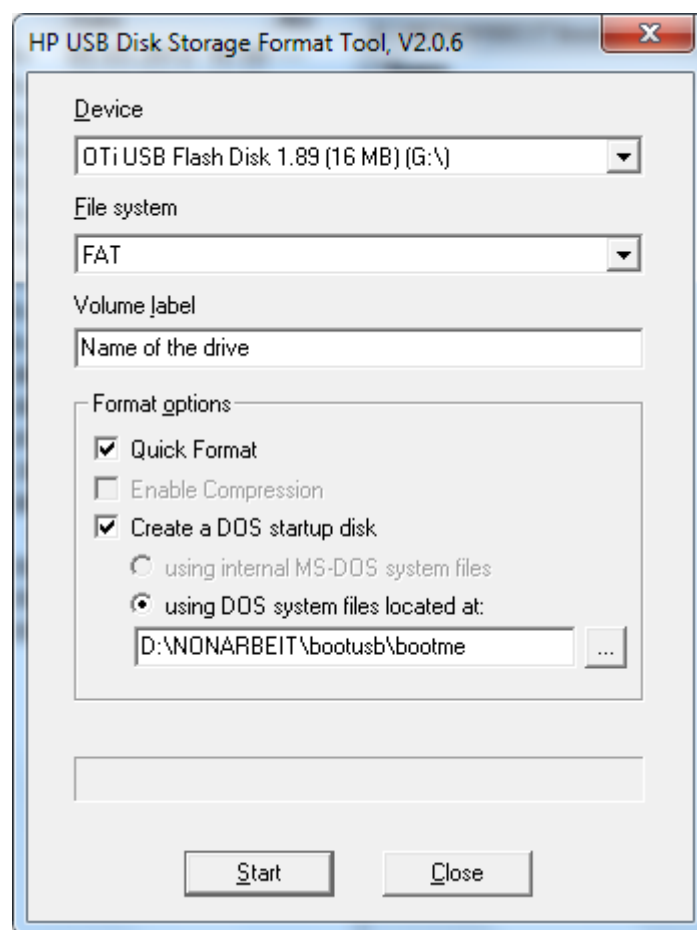
Connect the USB Stick to your Computer

Start the HP Tool

Choose the USB Stick from the drop-down-list, then the filesystem (FAT), and check the *Quick Format* and the *Create a DOS startup disk* boxes. (You can add a name to the USB Stick in the field *Volume label*)

The *using DOS system files located at* option will activate. Click on the square in order to locate the DOS files.

Browse to the folder where the DOS files are stored and select it.



Now click on *Start*

A warning message will appear on the screen, informing that all data on the stick will be erased. Choose *Yes*

The device will be partitioned and then formatted.

After the HP Tool has finished creating the bootable USB Stick, you can simply copy the files on the USB Stick (you don't need to create a new folder, simply copy the files to the USB Stick).

Your bootable USB Stick is now ready.
